Project description	The drinking water is a big challenge here in Kalika as the settlement is situated in the uphill and there is no natural water source nearby in the higher point of the village. So, the community have to invest hours to fetch water from the downhill every day. Women and children are mostly carrying the water in Doko (a kind of basket made from bamboo, which is woven by hand in netted form).  The community of Kalika via Nepal Red Cross Society (NRCS) Kaski came with a request to Unica Foundation if we could support for the drinking water supply project there. Now the study of the project feasibility is completed. We are closely working with Grundfos (the world's largest pump manufacturer), solar company in Nepal as well as the NRCS and the community so that we could come up with best possible option to supply the drinking water.
